## 6. Canine Control And Care Trust

Canine Control and Care Trust (CCC), a charitable trust registered under the Bombay Charitable Trust Act 1950 with the registration number E 6964 (Pune) was established on September 30, 2015. Their core belief is that stray dog population management should be humane and ethical, minimizing harm and maximizing benefits for the dogs involved as well as the human communities. CCC endeavors to enhance stray dog welfare over their lifetime and reduce the human-animal conflict over time as neutered and vaccinated dogs are no threat to society. CCC is also certified by the Animal Welfare Board of India.

CCC has sterilized stray dogs as a public service from 2015 onwards at no cost to the public or government. They have successfully sterilized 1,00,000+ stray dogs across PMC and PCMC reducing suffering, preventing overpopulation, and eliminating rabies and other diseases through anti-rabies and 9-in-1 vaccination drives to ensure a better quality of life for stray dogs. They have created an Animal Welfare Board of India (AWBI) recommended 5-day Animal Birth Control (ABC) program which allows them to maximize favorable outcomes for the dogs

## 7. I-Share Foundation

I-SHARE Foundation is a Pune-based not-for-profit organization formed with a mission to Innovate Solutions for Healthcare Access Research and Education.
